

Fire Labyrinth

When you reach the centre, **place the incense in the fire** as a symbol of your prayers and watch the smoke rise high.

Take a large foot print and write your name on it.

Wait until the next person comes in and then **pass it on** to them.

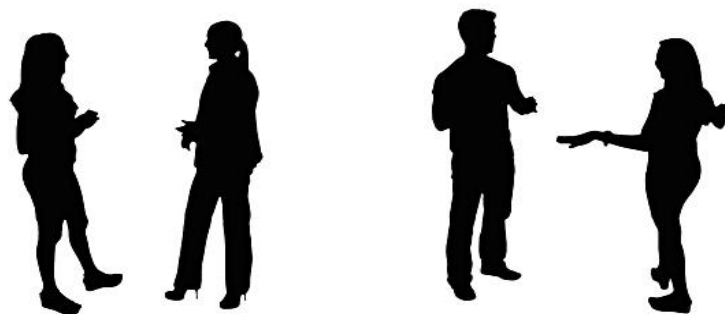
Imagine yourself passing on the Light of Jesus to a person you know. **Pray** for that person before you leave.
